

HYSA PRESIDENTS DAY TOURNAMENT
FIELD MARSHALL DUTIES

As part of participation in the tournament, the tournament requests that a volunteer from the teams entered assist with field marshall duties. Team assignments are assigned on a random basis and we try not to assign neighbor island teams. Team assignments will generally be at the field and game time that the volunteer's team will be playing. Teams that do not provide a volunteer may be fined by the tournament.

Field marshalls are required to assist in identifying injuries that occur during the tournament games. Player safety is priority during the tournament.

Field Marshall Check-In Procedures:

- Team volunteer to **check-in** by assigned time at tournament **Main Tent**. Main Tent is located by the Waipio ticket booth directly in front of the Waipio restrooms.
- Team volunteer will provide their cell phone number in case the radio provided is not operable.
- Team volunteer will be provided with a field marshall vest, lanyard and radio. If the volunteer is the second through last game of the day, the field marshall vest and radio may be at the field marshall tent. **Please** check-in at Main Tent before proceeding to assigned field.
- Team volunteer will be assigned to game field(s). A tent in the location of the game field(s) assigned will generally be provided for the volunteer. Exception is for games in the Stadium.

Field Marshall Duties:

- Check-in with Main Tent that volunteer has arrived at their designated field marshall area. Check-in by radio – “Main tent, Field 5 field marshall checking in.”
- Radio when game on field(s) assigned commences – “Game on Field 5 has started”. This allows the referee tent and main tent to note that game has started on time.
- Radio if there is a player injury. Radio when referee/coach requests for you to call a trainer.

If injured player is on field – “Trainer needed for Field 5, player on field in white jersey”.

If injured player taken on field/player needs ice/wrap, etc – “Trainer needed for Field 5, player in white team tent”.

- Radio if referee requires assistance. Referee will inform volunteer of what is being requested.
- Radio if water or cups are needed for referees – “Main tent water or cups needed at field marshall tent located by field 5”.
- Radio when game on field(s) has been completed – “Game on field 5 ended”.

At end of shift, please stay at your designated field marshall area. Your replacement should be coming shortly. When replacement arrives, please turn over field marshall vest, lanyard and radio to the new volunteer. If your shift is the last for the field(s) you are assigned, please return field marshall vest, lanyard and radio to the Main Tent.

Field Marshall that has the last game of the day – please lower tent by dropping tent legs to lowest setting. Leave tent pegged into ground.

Field Set-up/Take-down Duties:

- Check in with Main Tent by assigned time.
- Request for person in charge of Field Marshalls..
- Field Set-up duties to include: Set-up Field Marshall tent(s) at designated fields and other tasks requested by Tournament Director. Tent to be obtained by Main Tent area.
