

HYSA TOURNAMENTS
FIELD MARSHALL DUTIES (rev 2026)

The Tournament Committee depends on volunteers to assist with field marshal duties in order to maintain the safety of our players, coaches, referees and supporters. Team assignments are based on a random basis off of the game schedules so that volunteers will generally be situated near the field and during the game time of their team's game. Although we try not to assign **neighbor island teams**, there are rare instances when this cannot be avoided and we ask for your cooperation also. Teams that do not provide a volunteer may face disciplinary action.

Field Marshall Check-In Procedures:

- Team volunteer to **check-in** by assigned time at tournament **Main Tent (Waipio Ticket Booth)**. PLEASE DO NOT GO DIRECTLY TO YOUR ASSIGNED FIELD MARSHAL TENT.
- Team volunteer will be asked to provide their cell phone number in case the radio provided is not operable.
- Team volunteer will be provided with a field marshal vest and radio.
- A tent in the general location of the game field(s) assigned will generally be provided for the volunteer. Exception is for games in the Stadium and Field 5. You may want to bring a chair to sit on as none will be provided. Please note that field marshal tents are for field marshals and referees only and not for coaches, spectators, or any other persons. Please also remember to monitor all games you are assigned to and not just the one your child is playing in.

Field Marshall Duties:

- Radio if there is a player injury. The referee/coach will request you to call the trainer. To expedite the response for the injured person, please note the field #, general area where player is located and jersey color. In serious injury situations, it would be helpful if you can also state the suspected injury so trainers will know to give this player a higher priority.

If injured player is on field – “Trainer needed for Field 5, player on field in white jersey”.

If injured player taken off field – “Trainer needed for Field 5, player in blue jersey under team tent”.

If player sustained “serious” injury – “Trainer needed for Field 5, possible concussion, player in green jersey”

- Radio if referee requires assistance. Referee will inform volunteer of what is being requested.
- Radio if game does not start on time as this may cause a backup of future games.
- Radio when game on field(s) has been completed – “Game on field 5 ended”. Referee crews to pick up referees.

Your shift ends when all games you are monitoring are completed. We will contact you when your replacement checks in and is headed to your tent. Please do not leave the radio and vest in the tent until your replacement arrives. If your replacement did not check in and your shift has ended, please bring the radio and vest back to the ticket booth.

Field Marshall that has the last game of the day – please lower tent by dropping tent legs to lowest setting. Leave tent pegged into ground.
